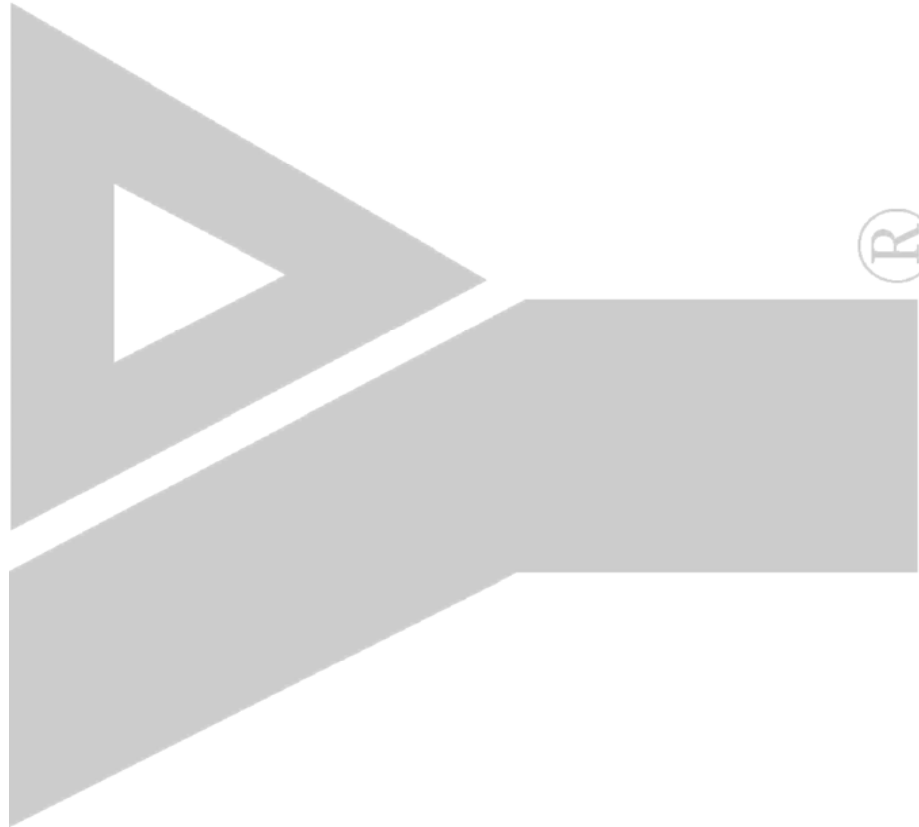

Summer 2010 Boys and Girls Basketball Leagues

Registration: Registration is available at the YMCA office (6135 Tam O' Shanter Dr.) from May 1st - June 11th. Two sign-up days will be held at Sierra Middle School gyms (6747 Harrisburg Place) on Saturday, May 22nd & 29th between 9-11 am. Registration must be in person and is limited by a maximum number of players at each grade level.

Fees: \$70: A \$70 per player (checks made payable to "YMCA", a Non-Profit Corporation.) Fee includes Jersey, Medallion, and 8 games. Plus a once a year \$10 Membership fee for the YMCA of San Joaquin County if you have not played with the YMCA since January 1, 2010.

League Play Begins: Summer league games will begin Monday July 5, 2010. Practice will begin two weeks prior to game schedule.

League Clinic:
 There will be a one day clinic, one June 19th, with the Lincoln High School basketball coaches for all players grades 5th through 8th grade. Boys and Girls 4th - 6th grades will be from 9am -10:30am and 7th & 8th grades will be from 11am -1pm.

We Need Coaches.
 YMCA-Lincoln Youth Basketball is a great program for our kids and our community. All of our coaches are volunteers. We are actively recruiting coaches and assistant coaches for this season. All of our coaches will have the opportunity to attend a coaching clinic conducted by Lincoln High School's outstanding basketball coaching staff. The clinic will teach age-specific skills and give helpful hints to create a worthwhile basketball experience for kids. Coaches need to be 18 years of age and submit to a fingerprint check.
